Local Plans	A local plan is a statutory document that sets out the council's vision and strategies for future development. Preliminary Flood Risk Assessment (PFRA)	An assessment of floods that have taken place in the past and floods that could take place in the future. They considers flooding from surface water runoff, groundwater and ordinary watercourses. LLFAs must review their PFRAs every 6 years.	http://www.essex.gov.uk/ flooding
Surface Water Management Plan (SWMP)	A plan which outlines the preferred surface water management strategy in a given location. In this context surface water flooding describes flooding from sewers, drains, groundwater, and runoff from land, small water courses and ditches that occurs as a result of heavy rainfall.	http://www.essex.gov.uk/ flooding
